It will begin promptly at 10:00 a.m. at the corner of Williams and Broad Streets (by Dunkin Donuts) near the park, proceed down Broad to State Street where the reviewing stand will be on the left in front of City Hall, go right onto Bank Street and finish by the Bank Street Fire House. All marchers must be at their check-in point **NO LATER than 9:00 a.m.** The parade route is approximately one mile long and marchers should anticipate marching for about one hour. Participants are invited to the Waterfront Park (behind the train station) for refreshments after the parade.
